The hip feel of one of Scottsdale's hottest new nightspots draws a regular crowd of 20-, 30-, and 40-somethings. The glitz and glamour of the customers often rivals the feather boas and sparkle of the Jackrabbit Bunnies.

The deep blue and vibrant pink lights of the club showcase the stage positioned behind the massive bar. The live band and DJ round out the shows. If the crowd gets going and the entertainment heats up, you might just catch one of the girls dancing across the bar. The venue has ample seating but still fills up to a standing-room-only crowd on weekends.

Even with one of the hottest shows in town, Jackrabbit Supper Club is more than the entertainment. The dinner menu features sandwiches, burgers, and salads with a gourmet twist, decadent desserts and a full drink menu. The extensive wine list offers a fine selection of reds, whites, sparkling wines and champagnes. The specialty martinis crafted with top shelf liquors are worth the visit.

The VIP lounge is popular with celebrities who frequent Jackrabbit, as well as locals who come to see-and-be-seen. Be sure to call ahead to reserve a spot in the lounge. Jackrabbit Supper Club is open Thursday through Saturday from 8 p.m. to 2 a.m. and dinner is served until 11 p.m. Entertainment begins nightly at 8 p.m. and features the Jackrabbit Bunnies, live band, and DJ.
